RE: Quartz Mining License QML-0011 Quarterly Wildlife Report December 2018

Paragraph 13.8 of the Quartz Mining License QML-0011 issued to StrataGold Corporation requires the Licensee to provide quarterly monitoring reports on wildlife observations and incidents to the Director and the Inspector on the first working day in March, June, September and December of each year. The information contained herein with respect to wildlife reporting represents the quarterly monitoring report and includes all observations collected in September, October and November 2018.

In November, a red fox was found on the crusher access road with a suspected broken back from a vehicle collision. The fox was ultimately euthanized by site services and all relevant details communicated to the Mayo Conservation Officer. The Mayo CO will be returning to site in early December to follow up directly with the personnel involved in the incident.
