**Re: Sä Dena Hes Mine Quartz Mining License QML-0004 – Extension of Time Limit
for Final Submission of Detailed Decommissioning and Reclamation Plan**

Pursuant to section 4.1 of Quartz Mining License QML-0004 (the "License") for the Sä Dena Hes Project, Teck Resources Limited submitted a request on October 31st, 2014 to extend the time limit for the final submission of the Detailed Decommissioning and Reclamation Plan (the "DDRP") from November 1st, 2014 to April 30th, 2015.

My letter to you of July 18th, 2014 requires that the Licensee carry out technical field studies in support of the Undertaking conducted during the decommissioning phase and report the result of the studies in the DDRP by November 1st, 2014.

The extension request indicated that, although the technical field studies were conducted during the decommissioning phase in 2014, the result of these studies will not be available until early 2015. The requested extension to April 30th will provide time for the Licensee to obtain the results and make necessary change to the DDRP.

I am of the view that, since no physical work will be completed during the winter and since this DDRP is expect to be the last amendment before the expiry of the License, it is important to give proper time to consider the study results. Therefore, I agree that the deadline for submission of the final DDRP is extended to April 30th, 2015.
