Re: Addendum to General Site Plan V2011-05 for Access Gate and Lower Site Road

Pursuant to Section 6.2 of Quartz Mining Licence QML-0006 ("the Licence"), for the Wolverine Mine Project, Yukon Zinc Corporation ("YZC") submitted a request for two specific amendments to the *General Site Plan V2011-05* ("GSP"), to the Chief for review and approval. This amendment request, in the form of a letter dated May 16th, 2016, was received in my office electronically and detailed the following requests:

- 1) Addition of the "Site Road" – extending from the north-west edge of the mine site to Wolverine Lake – as a minimally maintained road for access to environmental monitoring sites at and around Wolverine Lake. YZC is requesting it be added to the GSP, and included in any future updates to the Reclamation and Closure Plan to include appropriate closure activities and bonding requirements.
- 2) Removal of the obligation to establish a secondary access control gate on the main access road – as detailed in Section 5.3.4 of the GSP. YZC feels the currently maintained gate located at the confluence of the access road with the Robert Campbell Highway is sufficient enough to deny public access to the site.

I have reviewed this General Site Plan amendment request and have determined that it is approved, effective immediately subject to the following conditions:

- 1) "Figure 1.2-2" contained in the amendment request, is added to "Section 2.2 Mine Site Infrastructure " of the GSP;

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- 2) the next update to the Reclamation and Closure Plan must include the "site road" and include appropriate closure activities and costing; and
- 3) Portions of Section "5.3.4.1 Temporary Closure Access Control" that refer to the installation of a "temporary access control gate" and Figure 3 are removed from the GSP.

As stated in section 6.3 and 6.5 of the Licence, you are authorized to carry out the activities in accordance with the amended General Site Plan. Schedule C of the License has been revised to reflect this approval and is also attached to this letter. This amended Schedule C replaces all earlier versions.
