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Terms and Conditions

Chance Oil and Gas Limited (the "Licensee") is authorized to conduct a geoscience operation program on Yukon lands in the area within NTS blocks 116I and 116H between Latitude 66o N and Latitude 66o 50' N and Longitude 137o 20' W and Longitude 136o 40' W, from July 10, 2019 to July 24, 2019, in accordance with its application for a geoscience exploration licence dated June 5, 2019, including subsequent submissions for that application made on June 12 and June 26, 2019, and in accordance with the Oil and Gas Geoscience and Exploration Regulations, on the following conditions:

- 1 The Licensee shall provide a written notification to the Chief Operations Officer at least 24 hours prior to the start of the geoscience operation program.
- 2 This Licence shall not be construed as affecting any obligation the Licensee may have under a Federal, Territorial, or Municipal law.
- 3 The Licensee shall submit a report on Monday morning every week while the geoscience operation program is ongoing, including the following information for the respective week prior to the report submission:
 - a. sites visited;
 - b. outcrops logged; and
 - c. samples taken for analysis.
- 4 The Licensee shall submit a health and safety activity report on Monday morning each week every week while the geoscience program is ongoing, including the following information for the respective week prior to the report submission:
 - a. personnel involved;
 - b. total flying hours per day, per week, and cumulative total over the whole program;
 - c. injuries, incidents, and near misses;
 - d. general description of weather; and
 - e. wildlife sightings and incidents
- 5 The Licensee shall submit, within one month following the end of the field program, a field program summary report including the following information:
 - a. general summary of field work:
 - b. samples that have been sent for lab analysis;
 - c. expected timing of laboratory results; and
 - d. expected timing of Geological Operation Final Report (including laboratory analytical results) that will be delivered to the Chief Operations Officer.
- 6 The Licensee shall submit a Geological Operation Final Report for the geoscience operations program within 12 months after completion of field activities, including all the requirements for a Geological Operation Final Report listed in the Guidelines: Reporting & Requirements for Geoscience Programs & Operations, available online at http://www.emr.gov.yk.ca/oilandgas/pdf/guidelines_geoscience_program_reporting.pdf
- 7 The application and subsequent submissions by the Licensee form part of the terms and conditions of this Geoscience Exploration Licence. If there is a discrepancy between the application and subsequent submissions and the conditions of this licence, the conditions of this licence shall prevail.
