Re: Quartz Mining License QML-0007 – Request for Temporary Closure Extension

On April 15, 2009, Quartz Mining License QML-0007 (the "License") for the Carmacks Copper Project was issued for the development, operation and closure of a heap leach copper mine. Since the issuance of the License, neither development nor production activities have occurred, as such, the Undertaking is considered to be in a state of Temporary Closure as defined in the License. Section 12.6 of the License states that if the period of temporary closure is to exceed five years the Undertaking would be deemed to be in a state of Permanent Closure unless otherwise directed by the Chief.

A request to extend the period of Temporary Closure period was made in a December 4, 2015 letter from Doug Ramsey to me entitled "Carmacks Project - QML-0007 - Request for Extension of Temporary Closure. This letter indicated ongoing efforts by Copper North Mining Corp. to refine the mine plan and enter the environmental assessment and permitting processes in 2016, including amendments to the License.

I am satisfied that an extended period of Temporary Closure does not pose any additional environmental risk and therefore authorize the extension to April 15th, 2020.

You are reminded that pursuant to section 12.4 of the License, during Temporary Closure the temporary closure activities identified in the approved Reclamation and Closure Plan must be conducted; and pursuant to section 16.5.20 of the license these activities must be reported in the Annual Report.
