Dear Mr. Holmes,

Clause 12.6 of QML-0007 indicates that after five continuous years of Temporary Closure the Undertaking is to move into Permanent Closure unless otherwise directed by the Chief. In this regard Copper North is writing to request an extension of the period of Temporary Closure.

As indicated in our meeting on November 17, 2015, Copper North is working on substantive changes to the metallurgical process and tailings management plan for the Project and we plan to re-enter the environmental assessment and permitting process in the second half of 2016. Extension of the period of Temporary Closure through the period of environmental assessment and licensing is consistent with our plan to take the improved Carmacks project into production once the necessary approvals are in place.
