RE: Quartz Mining License QML-0011 Quarterly Wildlife Report

The Quartz Mining License QML-0011 issued to Victoria Gold Corp. (VGC) requires the Licensee to provide quarterly monitoring reports of wildlife observations and incidents to the Director and the Inspector on the first working day in March, June, September, and December of each year (Clause 13.8). The information contained herein with respect to wildlife reporting represents the quarterly monitoring report and includes observations collected in June, July, and August 2023, from the Eagle Gold Mine site.

Site activities were ongoing through the reporting period with regular wildlife observations. Wildlife mitigation measures continue to be implemented through mandatory Project site orientation, traffic control policies, pre-clearing wildlife surveys prior to vegetation disturbance, bulletins and memos, and implementation of the Project's management plans including the wildlife observation reporting program. Ongoing education is provided to site workers during toolbox meetings, through informational bulletins related to observing and documenting wildlife, and managing site waste according to permits and best practices.

Major construction and clearing work is prioritized to be conducted outside of the breeding bird window. However, on June 3rd, while conducting an inspection for nesting birds in the HLF area, a potential nest site was observed near the HLF pregnant leach solution pump casings. Sustained observations were conducted to evaluate the presence of nesting birds, during which time 5-6 birds were seen entering and exiting the nest. No work was being performed near the area and signage/flagging were set up after the nest was observed. Although no work was scheduled in the area for the duration of the summer, continual checks were made on the nests until the end of the breeding window (Mid to late August).

There were two wildlife mortalities documented on site in July and August:

- A deceased Raven was found on the HLF 1041 lift on July 9. The Raven was bagged and the local CO engaged for processing directions. The Raven was sent off site to the Mayo Fish and Wildlife Office for further testing.
- A Sparrow was found deceased in an open trailer on the lower road on August 27. The head, feet, and guts had been removed from predation. The Sparrow was bagged and the local CO engaged for processing directions.

During the period of this report there were several observations of bears, moose, and lynx within the Project footprint. It is expected that the East Mcquesten Fire that impacted the surrounding Project area will have implications on wildlife abundance observed on the Project moving forward.
