RE: Quartz Mining Licence QML-0011 Quarterly Wildlife Report Spring 2018

Paragraph 13.8 of the Quartz Mining License QML-0011 issued to StrataGold Corporation requires the Licensee to provide quarterly monitoring reports on wildlife observations and incidents to the Director and the Inspector on the first working day in March, June, September, and December of each year. The information contained herein with respect to wildlife reporting represents the third quarterly monitoring report since commencement of the Eagle Gold Project Undertaking in August 2017, and includes all observations collected throughout December 2017 to the end of February 2018 (Table 1).

No wildlife incidents were recorded during this reporting period. All construction works to date have been conducted outside of the breeding bird window (May 1 – July 31) and no wildlife habitat features (e.g., mineral licks, dens, nest trees, snags, rocky outcrops, small ponds/seepages) have been identified in work areas. Wildlife mitigation measures were implemented during construction through site orientation/policies training and implementation of the Project's management plans including the wildlife observation reporting program.
