#### General Information

Trophy Stone Outfitting Ltd. is a family operated business based in Yukon. We value the land, and the people and animals that inhabit it. We aim to run an ethical, sustainable and adventurous outfitting business. Over the years since purchasing the outfit we have strived to maintain and repair our cabin sites. Tidy well maintained sites are extremely important to our operation; not only for discouraging wildlife from causing damage, but it also improves the experience for the clients.

The sites that we are requesting leases and licences for in this application are essential to operate the business.

We will continue to preserve existing cabins, keeping the areas tidy and free of debris and garbage, this regular maintenance is required to operate the business. The primary purpose for our request for the leases and licences is to identify existing structures on the sites, to eliminate potential land use conflicts, while also recognizing the seasonal use of the structures and sites.

It should be noted that any improvements suggested to selected sites that was highlighted in the Yukon Land Inspection Report has either already been completed by the date of this application, or is slated to be completed during the 2017-2018 winter season.

All the outfitting camps applied for have had significant historic use and investment in permanent facilities, these facilities have been documented and are necessary to the ongoing operation of the outfitting concession.

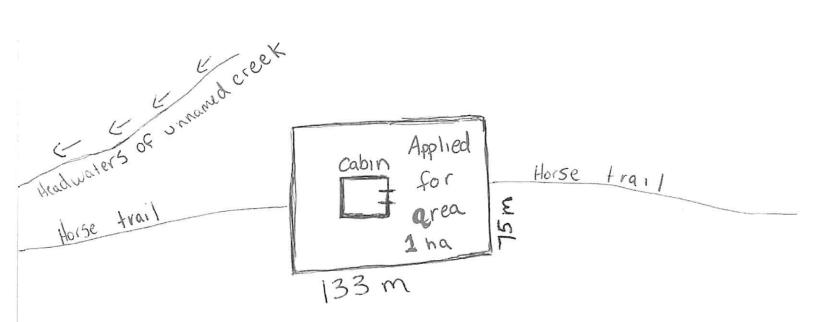

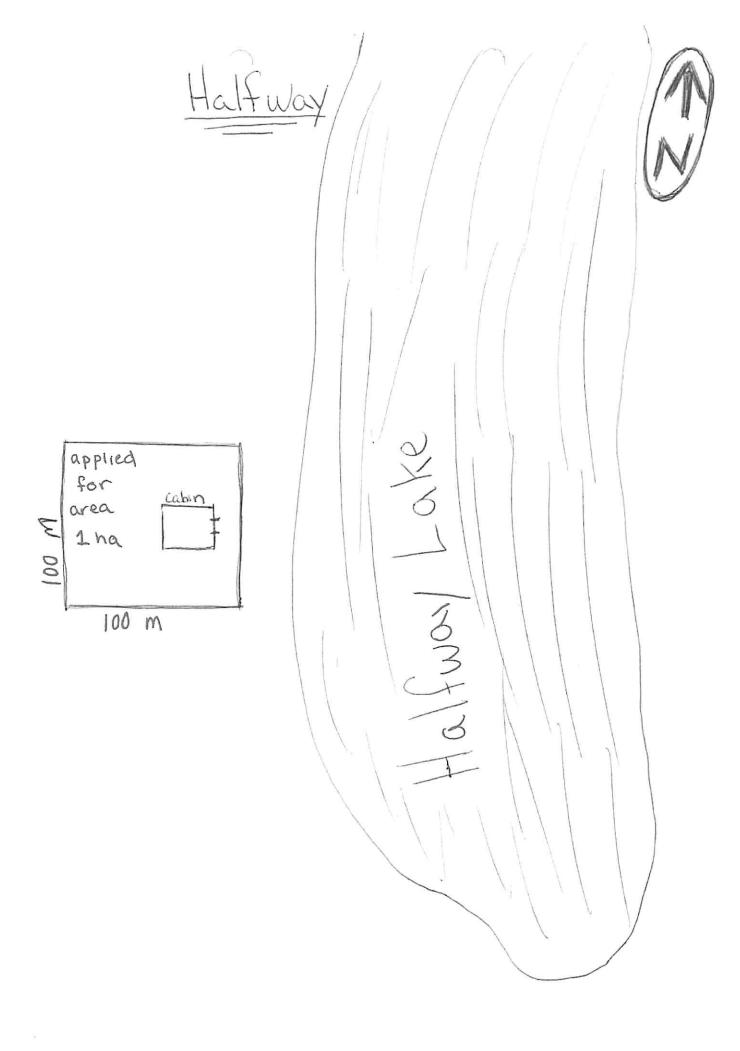

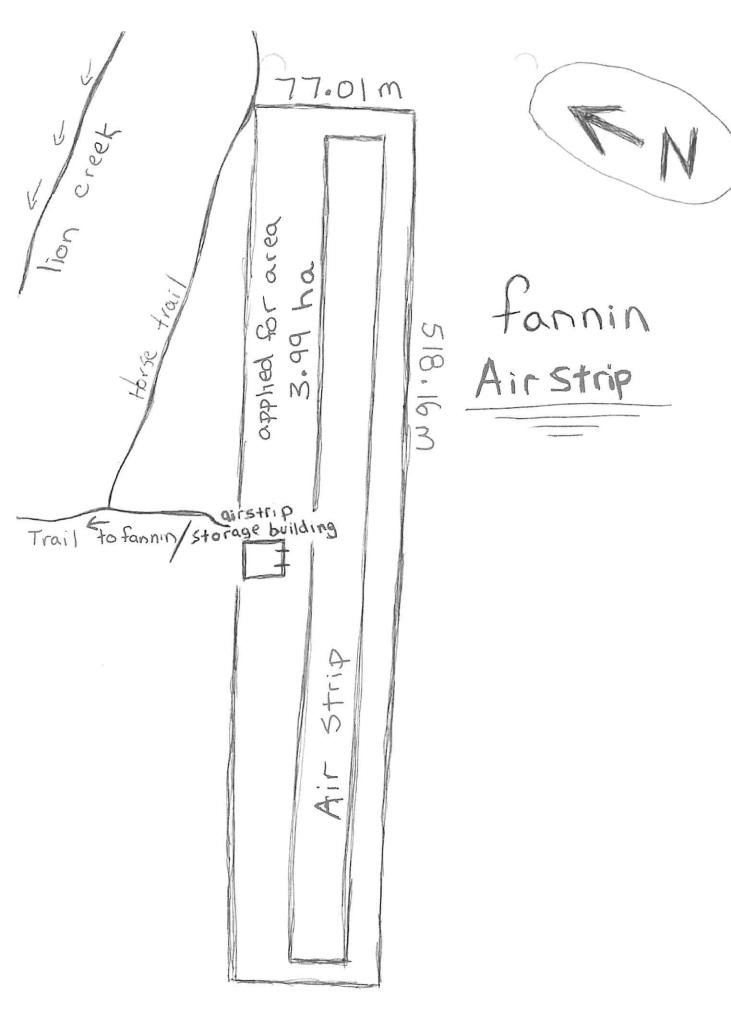
