Application to Amend a Drilling Authority

This application, in triplicate, must be submitted and approved before commencing operations. If the well location is changed, this application must be accompanied where required, with a plan of survey approved by the Surveyor General.

In compliance with the "Canada Oil and Gas Land Regulations", application is hereby made to amend Drilling

Authority No. 901, concerning Aquit. Alder. YT. C-33
. Aquitaine Company of Canada Ltd. hereby applies to amend the casing program
of the above mentioned exploratory well as follows:

Casing Size O.D. (Inches) Estimated Depth (Metres)
..... 30 34.5 m. (123 ft)
..... 20 88.6 m. (291 ft)
..... 13-3/8 500.0 m. (1,640 ft)

Reasons for the amendments: While running the 20 inch conductor casing, it
became stuck in the hole at 88.6 m. requiring that it be cemented at this
depth. Therefore, Aquitaine requests an amendment of the setting depths of
conductor and surface casing, as shown above, in accordance with Section 67
of the Canada Regulations.
