SUMMARY OF PROPOSED OPERATIONS

The program objectives is to abandon the well and eliminate migrating gases... and pressures experienced within the various casing strings. An attempt to obtain a Nahanni formation pressure will be made.

The program outline is as follows:

- Cut the existing tubing off above the packer (3830 MKB), perform USI/CBT log (evaluate casing & cement), perforate and cement squeeze, at the intermediate casing shoe, above the Mattson/Flett formations, at the surface casing shoe, at the conductor casing shoe and surface.
