SUMMARY OF PROPOSED OPERATIONS (See attached program)

Install wellhead. Run a casing scraper and circulate the well to water. Run a cement bond log. Swab fluid level down and perforate the Chance Sand underbalanced (1357.9 m to 1359.7 m KB and 1361.2 m to 1363.7 m KB). Swab test, acidize if necessary and repeat swab test. Kill well. Pull tubing. Equip the well for bottomhole hydraulic pumping and place the well on test.
